Background

The Breteau Foundation (BF) aims to enable disadvantaged children to reach their full potential through the delivery of digital educational tools. The Foundation is currently operational in multiple countries across the globe and reaches 26,000 children. The Volunteer STEAM Facilitators will be responsible for initially supporting the development of STEAM content for primary school children and delivering that content virtually or in-person if local COVID regulations permit it.

Key Responsibilities

This role will work closely with our Colombia Programme Manager to assist them with the development of our STEAM content for children either at-home or in schools. This will be initially a supporting content development role using existing STEAM content and will shift focus onto the delivery of that content either online or in-person if the volunteers have local residency to our programmes. The responsibilities will include:

- Researching, identifying and adapting home-based or school-based STEAM activities for the Foundation's programmes in Latin America.
- Developing suitable STEAM content and formats aimed at primary school children to target various settings including at-home or in-school and either virtually, in-person or through physical learning packs.
- Facilitating STEAM workshops virtually or in-person if based locally to one of our operating countries in Latin America.

Qualifications, Skills and Experience

The right candidate will need to be able to demonstrate their experience and skills relating to the responsibilities above. They will also be required to meet the relevant qualifications, skills and experience following:

- Knowledge in one or more of the STEAM subject areas.
- Experience working with children and developing educational content for children.
- Demonstrated experience in facilitating workshops either virtually or in-person.
- Experience working in a cross-cultural environment.
- Experience working in education, preferably in a primary school or NGO setting.
- Spanish and English Language skills



All volunteers are required to volunteer at the Foundation for a minimum of 3 months and complete a criminal record check. For this position, we are looking for either a remote or in-person volunteer who has visa permissions in the country they are residing in and who can commit to the equivalent of at least 1 day week.
