We are looking for a Volunteer UK Education Curriculum Specialist to assist our UK team with the rollout of our EdTech programme, specifically by reviewing educational apps, mapping them to the UK Primary School Curriculum and adapting teacher training workshops.

Key Responsibilities

The Volunteer UK Education Curriculum Specialist will work closely with our UK team and will support them with:

- Reviewing a selection of educational apps and mapping those apps to the UK Primary School Curriculum;
- Reviewing, adapting and strengthening the delivery of existing teacher training workshops.

Qualifications, Skills and Experience

The right candidate will need to be able to demonstrate their experience and skills relating to the responsibilities above. They will also be required to meet the relevant qualifications, skills and experience following:

- At least 3 years experience as an primary school educator or working with teachers in a learning setting and developing content and resources for teachers;
- Proficient skills in using tablets, downloading and familiarity with educational apps.

All volunteers are required to volunteer at the Foundation for a minimum of 3 months and complete a criminal record check. For this position, we are looking for a remote volunteer who can commit to at least 1 day/week.
