Key Responsibilities

The Volunteer Video Editor & Powerpoint Designer will work closely with our Lebanon, South Africa and UK Programme Managers to support them with:

- Designing and developing engaging presentations (either on Prezi, Canva or another recommended tool), integrating animated elements in a powerpoint video format.
- Cutting teacher training videos and integrating them into STEM/STEAM powerpoint video presentations.

Qualifications, Skills and Experience

The right candidate will need to be able to demonstrate their experience and skills relating to the responsibilities above. They will also be required to meet the relevant qualifications, skills and experience following:

- Experience working on video editing software
- Experience in developing engaging video presentations and powerpoint, preferably within education settings
- Experience working in a non-profit, preferably within education

All volunteers are required to volunteer at the Foundation for a minimum of 3 months and complete a criminal record check. For this position, we are looking for a remote volunteer who can commit to at least 1 day/week.
